Wisconsin 4-H Foundation 2012 Scholarship Guidelines

Minimum Eligibility Requirements

- Applicant must have a high school graduation date of June, 2012 or earlier.
- Applicant must have been a Wisconsin 4-H member for at least one year.
- Applicant must be enrolled or planning to enroll as an undergraduate in a university, college, or technical school during the 2012-2013 academic year.
- Applicant must have a current grade point average of at least 2.5 on a 4.0 scale.
- Applicant must meet other eligibility requirements specific to individual scholarships.
- Applicant is not eligible to receive a scholarship in an area for which they previously received one.

Selection Criteria

Scholarship applications will be reviewed by a qualified, impartial committee applying the following criteria:

- Demonstrated personal growth and development through Wisconsin 4-H projects and activities.
- Held leadership roles in Wisconsin 4-H and other organizations.
- Academic record.
- Financial need.
- Sense of direction in future educational goals.

Scholarship Application Procedures

- Scholarship applications are available beginning in December 15, 2011, and can be downloaded from the Wisconsin 4-H Foundation website www.uwex.edu/ces/4h/foundation, or by contacting the [Wisconsin 4-H Foundation, Kristi Thering-Tuschen at ktt@Wis4HFoundation.org or 608-333-2023](mailto:ktt@Wis4HFoundation.org).
- Carefully follow the directions on the application.
- Applications must be **EMAILED** by February 24, 2012 or they will not be considered. Mailed and fax copies of the scholarship application **cannot** be accepted.

Notification of scholarship awards will be made in May, 2012.

Distribution Procedures

Scholarship awards will be distributed upon completion of the first semester of enrollment at the university, college, or technical school during the 2012-2013 academic year. Prior to receiving their scholarship award, recipients will need to provide:

- A collegiate academic transcript for at least one term showing a cumulative grade point average of at least 2.0 on a 4.0 scale or academic good standing on another scale.
- A copy of current term fee slip or other document that confirms continued enrollment at the university, college, or technical school.

 - Applications must be typed or word processed, complete and made into an electronic file – PDF preferred or they will not be considered.
 - One application per scholarship area applied for.
 - Use only the space provided.
 - Do not attach separate sheets, clippings, etc., except for specific items listed below.
- 2) Include a copy of your most recent high school transcript and transcripts from all universities, colleges, or technical schools you have attended. Allow your school/s plenty of time to process your transcript request. If your school must send your transcripts directly to the Wisconsin 4-H Foundation, please note that on your application. At least one set of transcripts must be official. Additional scholarship applications may use photocopies of your official transcripts. *Applications received without transcripts will not be considered.*
- 3) Include one letter of recommendation with your scholarship application.
- 4) Go through the enclosed checklist to be sure all materials are in order and directions have been followed.
- 5) Submit your application and all required attachments to the Wisconsin 4-H Foundation. Application must be **EMAILED** by February 24, 2012 or they will not be considered. Mailed and fax copies of scholarship applications **cannot** be accepted.

BEFORE E-MAILING APPLICATION, CHECK TO MAKE SURE YOU HAVE:

- 1) Obtained all the necessary signatures on each application you are submitting.
- 2) Included your most recent high school transcript, any post secondary transcripts, and one letter of recommendation.
- 3) Filled out an application for each scholarship area you are applying for and verified that you meet all eligibility requirements for each scholarship you are applying for.

Available Scholarships

4-H Community Service Scholarship

Award: \$750 (1 scholarship awarded)

Francis & Phyllis Conrad Memorial Scholarships

Additional Eligibility Requirements:

- Applicant must be enrolled or planning to enroll in a university, college, or technical school located in Wisconsin.
- Applicant must have demonstrated his/her commitment to community service.
- Preference will be given to Clark County residents when there is a choice between equally qualified candidates.

4-H Agricultural Scholarship

Award: \$1,000 (1 scholarship awarded)

Additional Eligibility Requirements:

- Applicant must be a Wisconsin resident and have been a Wisconsin 4-H member for a minimum of one year.
- Applicant must be enrolled or planning to enroll in a university, college, or technical school.
- Applicant must be majoring in some aspect of agriculture and include some explanation of how they plan to use their education.
- Applicant must have a farm background or have been involved in agriculture-related 4-H activities.
- Applicant must have a current grade point average of at least 3.0 on a 4.0 scale.

4-H Leadership Scholarship

Award: \$1,000 (2 scholarships awarded)

Additional Eligibility Requirements:

- Applicant must have been active in a 4-H youth leadership activity for at least three years.
- Applicant must be enrolled or planning to enroll in a university, college, or technical school.

Elizabeth Salter-Eby Memorial Scholarship

Award: \$300 (1 scholarship awarded)

Elizabeth Salter-Eby Memorial Scholarship

Additional Eligibility Requirements:

- Applicant must have been active in a 4-H youth leadership activity for at least one year.
- Applicant must be attending a University of Wisconsin university or college.
- Applicant must be planning on pursuing a teaching degree or enrolled or planning to enroll in a childhood development, interior design, fashion design or a similar major with a tie to home economics or human ecology at any UW System campus.

4-H Natural Resources & Environmental Education Scholarship

Award: \$500 (1 scholarship awarded)

Additional Eligibility Requirements:

- Applicant must have been active in a 4-H Natural Resources and Environmental Education Project for at least one year.
- Applicant must be enrolled or planning to enroll in a university, college, or technical school.

4-H Animal Sciences Scholarship

Award: \$1,000 (1 scholarship awarded)

Oscar G. & Mary M. Woelfel Memorial Scholarships

Additional Eligibility Requirements:

- Applicant must be enrolled or planning to enroll in the College of Agricultural and Life Sciences at any of the University of Wisconsin campuses.
- Applicant must have a current grade point average of at least 2.5 on a 4.0 scale.
- Applicant must be from a rural community outside of Dane, Kenosha, Milwaukee, and Racine counties.

4-H Horse Scholarships

Award: \$1,000 (5 scholarships awarded)

Wisconsin 4-H Horse Association

Additional Eligibility Requirements:

- Applicant must have been a Wisconsin 4-H Horse and Pony Project member for a minimum of three years.
- Applicant must be enrolled or planning to enroll in a university, college, or technical school.
- Up to 25 additional points will be given to youth who have volunteered at Wisconsin State 4-H Horse Association activities and events and/or held youth leadership positions within the Wisconsin State 4-H Horse Association. **Be sure to include your Wisconsin State 4-H Horse Association activities in Section A, 4-H Leadership Activities.**
